They will also be responsible for renting of canoes and pedal boats to customers, along with maintaining and issuing safety equipment for rentals.

Specific Duties

- ◆ Selling food and beverages to park customers
- ◆ Responsible for taking orders and handling transactions
- ◆ Responsible for balancing daily cash reports
- ◆ Ensure food preparation is in compliance with Ontario Health Regulation
- ◆ Receiving and stocking of supplies
- ◆ Responsible for opening and closing facility as required
- ◆ Maintaining a clean and safe work and program areas
- ◆ Assist in the general maintenance and cleanliness of the park
- ◆ Responsible for maintaining and issuing safety equipment to boaters

Qualifications:

- ◆ Excellent customer service and public relation skills
- ◆ Food preparation experience is preferred.
- ◆ Basic math skills, so you can accurately account for cash and inventory
- ◆ Ability to work weekend, evenings and holiday shifts
- ◆ Self-starter, ability to work with minimal supervision

All successful candidates must be available to work the duration of the season, and possess their own Green Patch CSA approved safety boots. Must be willing to work in all weather conditions.
