- Providing clear instruction in the safe use of the equipment
- Ensure boating waivers are signed by clients
- Responsible for opening and closing facility as required
- ♦ Responsible for handling transactions/cash
- ♦ Balance daily cash receipts and prepare deposits
- Maintaining a clean and safe work area
- ♦ Providing quality customer service
- Daily cleaning and maintenance
- ♦ Refuse collection
- ♦ Ensure equipment is secured at end of shift
- Grounds maintenance in beach area
- Maybe required to assist gate house or maintenance staff on occasion

Qualifications

- ♦ Must be currently enrolled as a full time student
- Excellent customer service and public relation skills
- ♦ Experience in canoeing is an asset
- Knowledge of park facilities and activities
