Each summer, the Grand River Conservation Areas welcomes visitors to enjoy camping, swimming, boating, tubing, fishing and hiking.

We are looking for a hard-working, energetic students that want to be part of our team connecting people to the environment through outdoor experiences. This is a great opportunity to meet new people, work outside in an inspiring setting and gain valuable work experience.

Reporting to the Park Superintendent the Tubing Attendant staff are responsible for performing a variety of duties related to the operation of the Tubing concession with an emphasis on customer service. Every year thousands of visitors come to Elora for tubing making it an extremely busy location.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Verification of online tubing rental tickets
- 2. Issuing tubes and correct safety equipment to customers
- 3. Complete and explain registration waivers with customers
- 4. Responsible for balancing daily cash reports and preparing deposits
- 5. Ensure rental equipment is organized and stored safely at the end of the day
- 6. Receiving and stocking of supplies, ice and wood sales
- 7. Responsible for opening and closing facility as required
- 8. Provide clear and concise instruction to participants on the safe use of equipment and tubing related activity- Ex) route of travel, valuables, deposit return
- 9. Maintaining a clean and safe area.
- 10. Assist in the general maintenance and cleanliness of the park

Qualifications:

- 1. Must be currently enrolled as a full time student
- 2. Excellent attention to detail, customer service and public relation skills
- 3. Knowledge of park facilities and activities
- 4. POS and cash register experience an asset
- 5. Ability to work weekend, evenings and holiday shifts
